

Acrylic Supply List

Paints: (these are only suggested—You basically need red, yellow, blue and white) (the craft acrylic paints will work if you don't want to buy the more expensive acrylic paint. Look for a red, red, a blue, blue and a yellow, yellow.)

I use:

Quinacridone Magenta
Ultramarine Blue
Turquoise (Phthalo),
Hansa Yellow Medium
Hansa Yellow light
Transparent Yellow Iron Oxide
Transparent Pyrrole Orange
Titanium White
Pyrolle red
Quinacridone red
Quinacridone azo nickel gold
Teal
Any other colors that interest you.

Brushes:

half inch flat brush
A small brush to sign your name
A middle sized round brush if desired
Either bigger or smaller flat brushes than 1/2" if desired
Rubber gloves if you want to paint with your fingers.

- Acrylic Glazing liquid or retarder
- Palette (you can use paper plates or palette paper)
- Paper or canvas (watercolor paper works for this as well)
- Water containers with lids—plan to take your paint water home with you
- A piece of foamcore to use as a support for your paper or canvas
- An easel if desired
- A chair if desired
- Paper towels for wiping your brush
- Pencil and paper to make a preliminary sketch with
- Eraser
